The Vision for Biker haven Church:

A church that was laid back and took the stand that Christ isn't concerned about the outside but is concerned with the inside and our heart connection with him, and therefore the dress at BHC is usually casual, jeans, tee-shirts and everyday attire. A church that loves unconditionally and welcomes anyone without concern for where your at in life now, but in an expectation of where Christ's word will lead you after hearing the word of God during our Sunday services and feeling the love of God thru each other. Our vision also was to have a meal together every Sunday after church to fellowship and spend ministry time with the congregation. Our vision also was to have groceries, cleaners, good available to give away to show not only our love and Gods love to them spiritually but tangibly, knowing that providing tangible needs as well as spiritual needs will show Christ's love.
